This hideaway on the shore of Lake Niassa (the Mozambique side of Lake Malawi) is "wild and woolly", says Tatler. To get there, you have to "scud across the border by boat and deal with a crazy man in a hut filling out peculiar forms – all very *Heart of Darkness*". But it's worth it for "the great whiplash of blond sand", "the bright blue water" and "the hammocks tied from tree to tree". By day, you "drink lemongrass tea and read". You can eat supper anywhere, even on "your own private beach". And at nightfall – "terribly early" – it's back to your hut, with nothing but a torch.
